

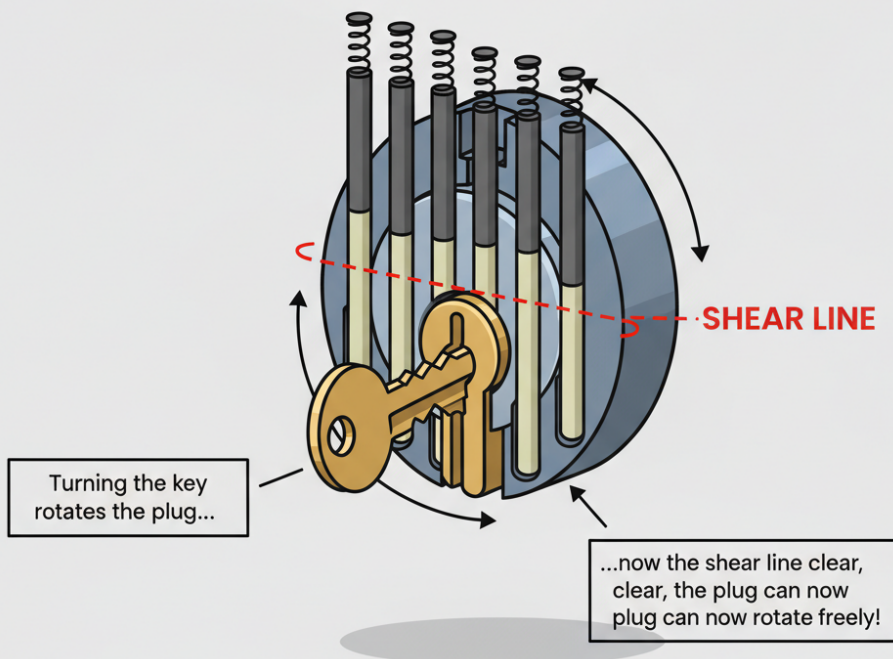

Why not every lock problem is the same

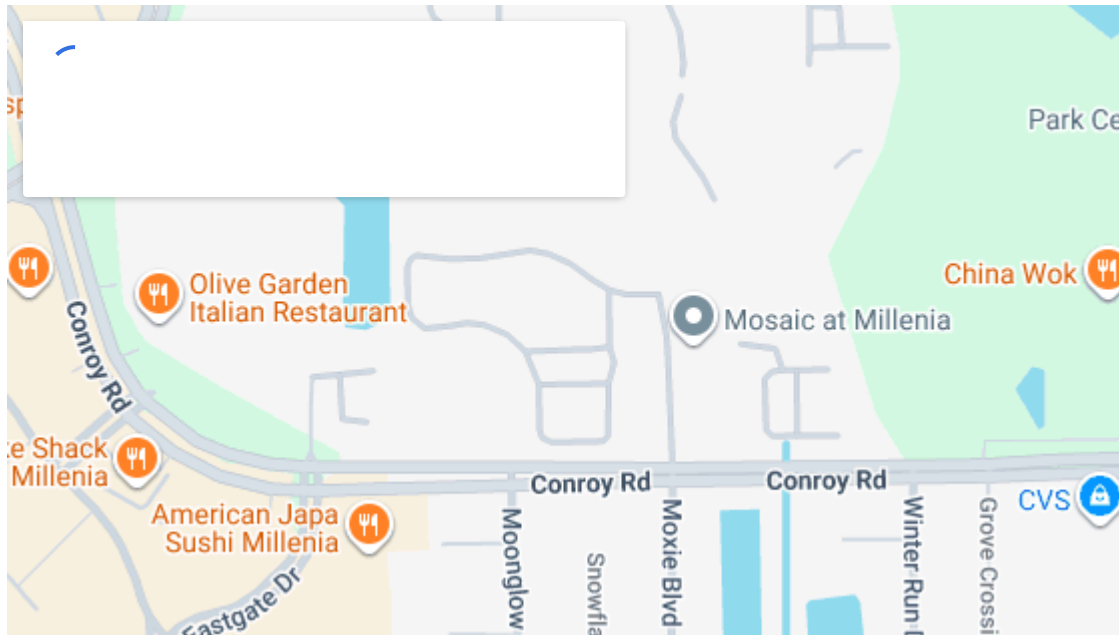
