

Most major appliances last between 8 and 15 years depending on type and use, but pushing them beyond that window exponentially increases failure risk and unexpected replacement costs. What Happens When You Keep Operating an Appliance Past Its Designed Service Window?

Appliances are engineered with a predictable lifespan. Manufacturers design components, seals, and electrical systems to function reliably within a specific timeframe. Once that window closes, you enter a zone of accelerating failure risk. The compressor in a refrigerator, the drum seal in a washing machine, or the heating element in an electric dryer all experience cumulative stress. Running these systems beyond their intended life doesn't just increase the chance of a single breakdown—it exposes you to cascading failures where multiple components fail in rapid succession, turning what might have been a single repair into a total replacement shock.

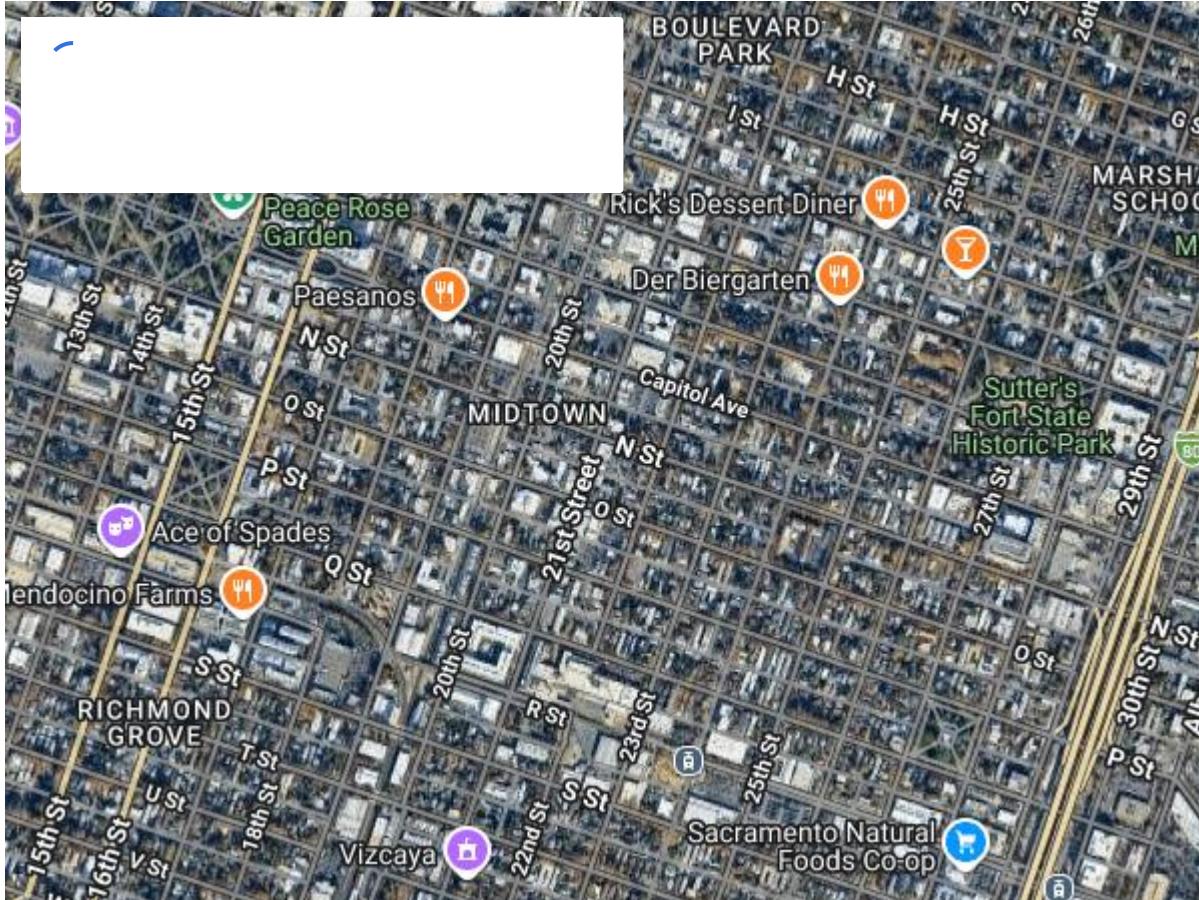
