- Clean and align the photo-eyes. Clean both sensor lenses with a soft cloth. The lights on each sensing unit should be consistent, not flickering. Adjust the braces so the lenses encounter each other directly and rest 4 to 6 inches off the flooring, then examination by passing a box via the beam of light as the door closes.
- Clear and lubricate the path. Move particles from the tracks, then wipe the rollers and joints with a dustcloth. Use a garage door ranked lubricant, not grease, to rollers, joints, and torsion spring bearing plates. Do not lube the tracks themselves. If you have a chain drive opener, a dab of grease on exposed chain segments can reduce chatter.
- Test balance and guidebook release carefully. With the door closed, pull the red launch cable to disconnect the opener. Lift the door by hand to mid elevation. If it remains within a few inches of where you leave it, your springs are roughly stabilized. If it knocks or shoots up, reconnect the opener and call a pro. Do not readjust springs yourself.

A wood door sags and scratches the jamb. Timber takes in dampness and can bow. 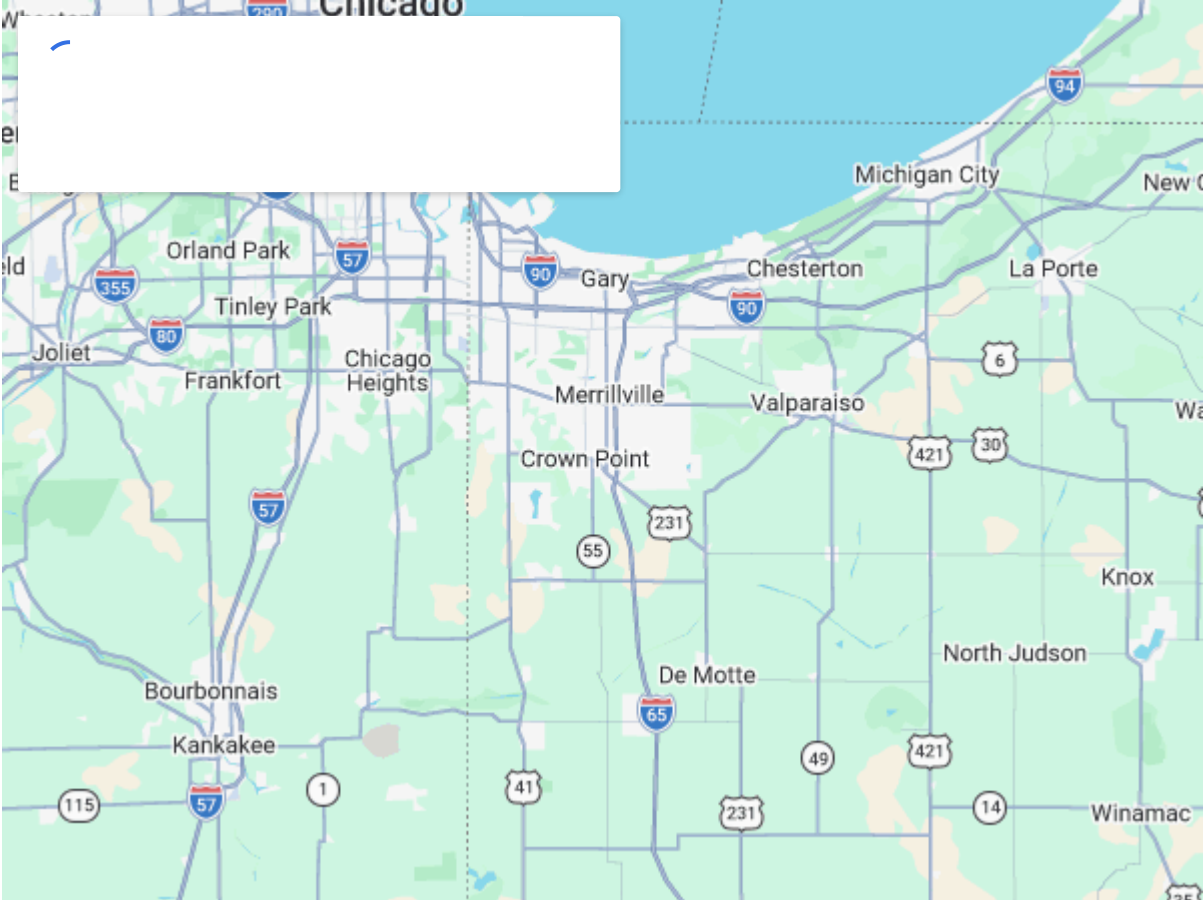
