Are Lighters Allowed on a Plane?

Can I Take a Lighter on Airplane Flights?

International flights may have additional restrictions depending on the destination country's aviation authority. Before departure, review both TSA regulations and your airline's baggage policies.

Can I Bring Lighters on a Plane in Checked Bags?

In most situations, TSA does not allow regular lighters in checked baggage unless they meet specific Department of Transportation packaging requirements. For this reason, carrying your lighter in your pocket or carry-on is usually the safer option.

When Might TSA Stop You?

TSA may stop you if:

- You carry multiple lighters.
- The lighter is a torch or jet-flame model.
- The lighter contains prohibited fuel.

- The item appears modified or unsafe.

In these cases, officers may inspect the item further or require you to surrender it before boarding.
