Ambient Lighting

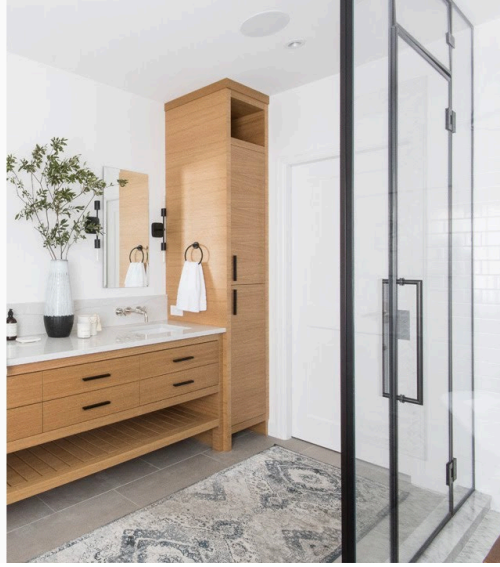
