No-see-um mesh, also called 20x20 or 20x30 weave, obstructs tiny insects that wind in throughout the wetter months. It minimizes airflow and lowers light slightly, so I recommend it for rooms backing to greenbelt or water, except every opening in the house.

Solar display textile blocks a high percentage of solar warm gain.
