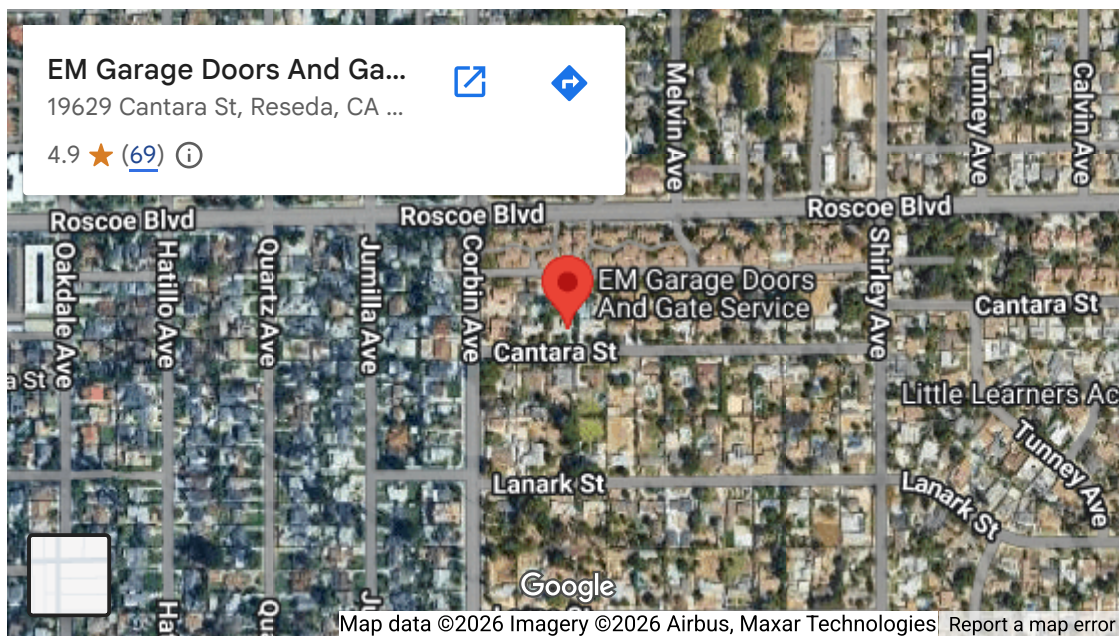


Garage Door Repair Solutions in Reseda
