Understanding cancellation policies can help reduce additional travel expenses.

Travel Documentation Requirements

Examples include:

- Death certificate information
- Hospital contact details
- Physician information
- Funeral home information
- Relationship verification

Documentation requests depend on the situation and the type of assistance being provided.

Providing accurate information can help customer service representatives process requests more efficiently.



Tips for Saving Money During Emergency Travel

Last-minute travel can be expensive.

Book Immediately

Ask About Available Flexibility

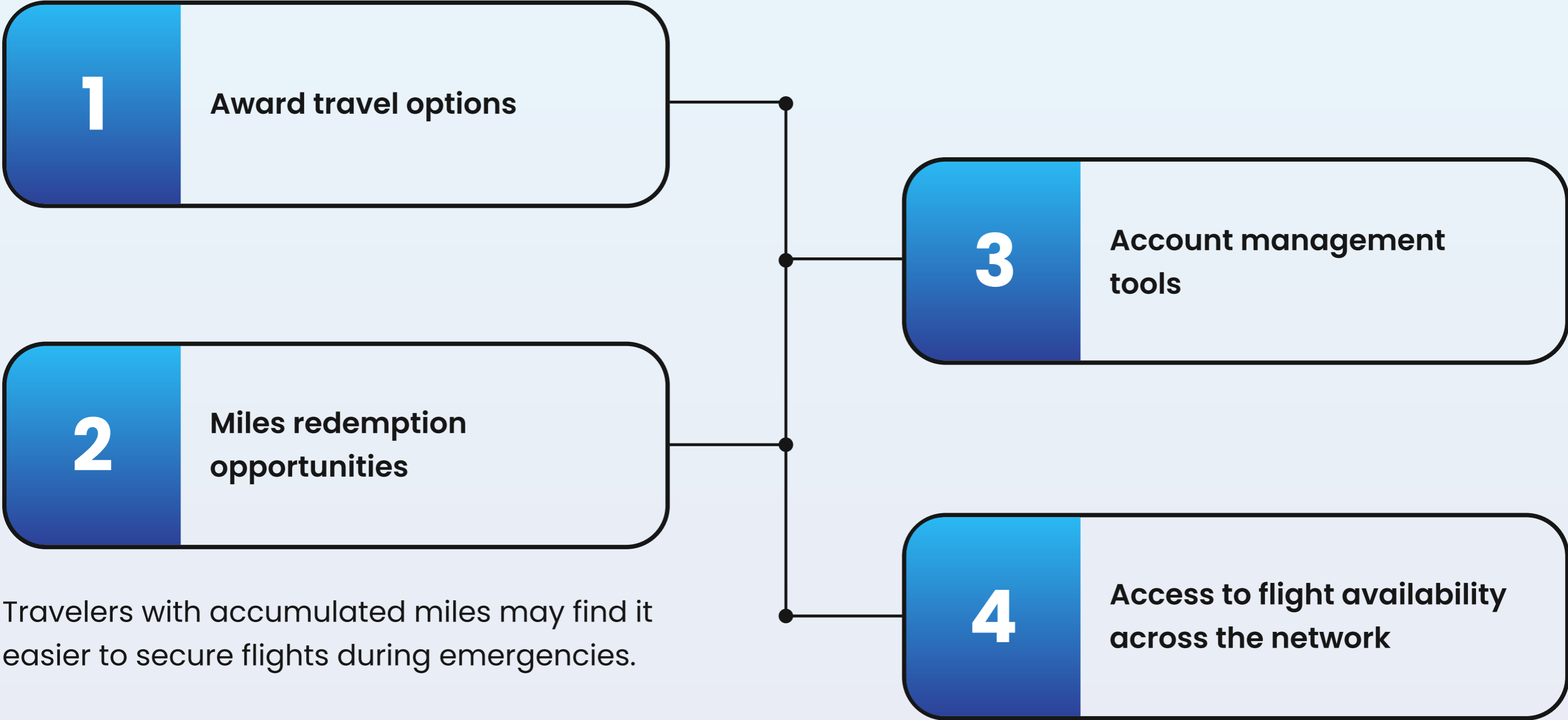
Customer service representatives can explain current travel options and policies.
