

If you are going to attend the Polynesian Fire Luau in Myrtle Beach, here is the inside knowledge that makes the most of the experience. The front rows offer the closest view of the fire knife finale. If your priority is maximum proximity to the performance, let the booking team know when you reserve that front row seating is your preference. Note that the room's ceiling sections can obstruct the view of high throws for some seat positions, so eye-level performance visibility is a factor worth considering when choosing seats. The cash bar opens before the show begins. If you want a tropical cocktail in hand for the opening of the dinner, arrive at or shortly after the 6:00 PM check-in and head to the bar before being seated.

The performers are genuine and warm after the show. Do not be shy about approaching the cast after the fire knife finale concludes. They enjoy meeting the audience and will engage with guests who come to thank them or ask questions.

Children in particular should be encouraged to say hello to the performers after the show. The lei you receive at arrival is not disposable. Performers sign leis for guests after the show. Keep yours through the evening and you will have an autographed souvenir that costs nothing extra and takes no effort to obtain beyond keeping the lei around your neck. Monday shows tend to [Dinner show myrtle beach](#) have slightly smaller audiences than Friday shows during peak season. If you prefer a more intimate atmosphere, a Monday booking often provides it.
