The incorrect one can saddle you with home damage, hazardous cuts, and a mess that lingers.

I have strolled enough lawns and climbed up enough trunks to know that trees are as specific as homes. 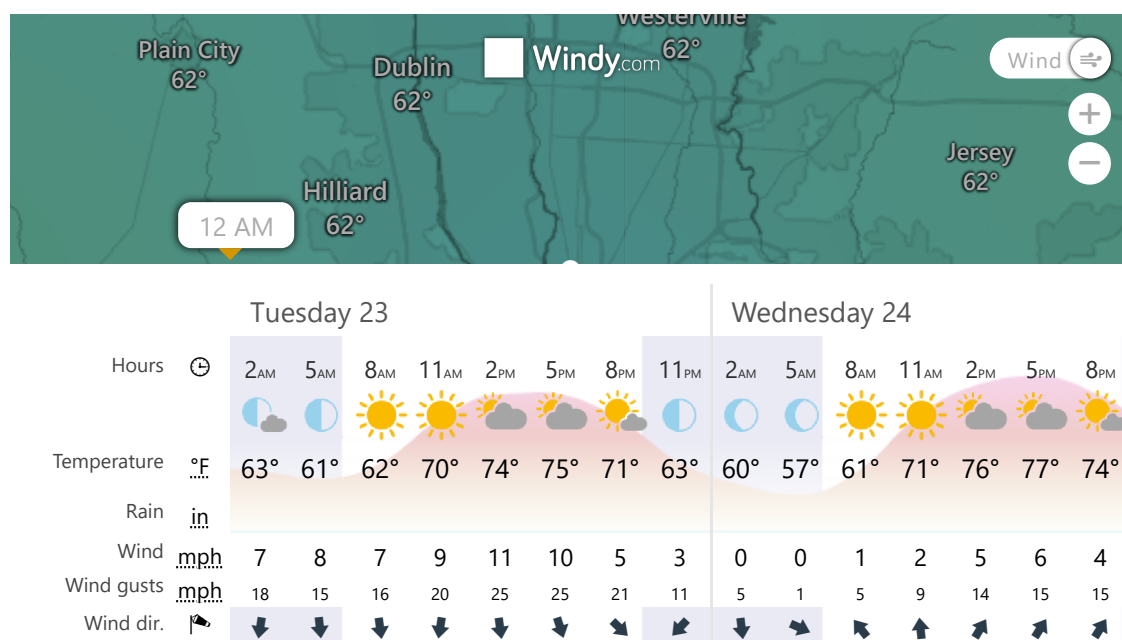
