What 24/7 response actually solves for an Orlando business

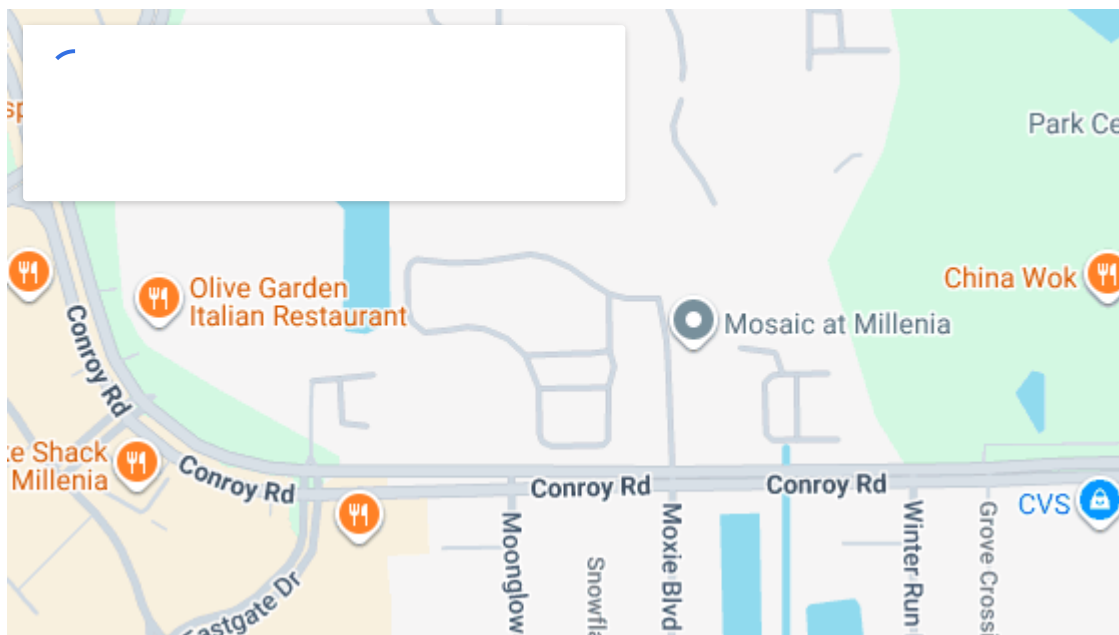

Licensing, bonding, and the quiet value of compliance
