

Introduction

Three trips. Two wrong parts. One lost weekend. That's how quickly a simple pipe repair turns into a two-day scramble when your supply pipeline isn't dialed in. In the field, minutes matter. A circulating pump waiting on a backorder or a PEX fitting that cracks under a pressure test isn't an inconvenience—it's a callback, a customer headache, and margin burned for nothing.
