

A cracked windshield has a way of turning an ordinary drive into a small expedition. One minute you are cruising through a familiar stretch of road, thinking about coffee, work, groceries, or the next exit. The next minute, a stone snaps off a truck tire, taps the glass with that sharp little tick, and leaves behind a star-shaped mark that seems to grow every time you look at it.
