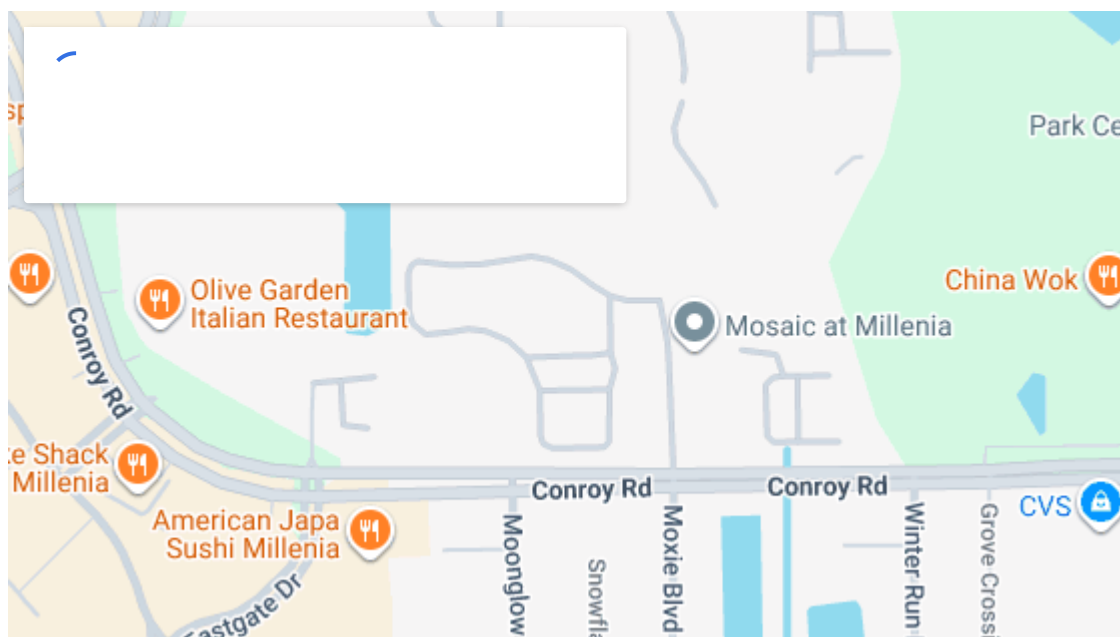
Vehicle locksmith work is more specialized than many people expect
