Key Colors for a Rustic Wedding Palette

Let’s talk shades first. To get that earthy romantic feel, skip neon and jewel tones. Try these families: faded vintage hues.

Think soft beige and oatmeal. Add dried eucalyptus. Then accent with chocolate brown. This specific palette looks like it grew out of the venue itself.

How to Light a Rustic Wedding

Don't underestimate evening lighting. When the sun is high, wood and flowers look great on their own. When evening truly settles in, lighting becomes everything.

The gold standard for rustic wedding style is warm string lights overhead. Layer with real pillar candles in hurricanes. Avoid overhead fluorescent.

Kollysphere agency once designed a rustic wedding hung copper wire lights inside wine bottles. The groom said it looked like a movie set. That's the power of good lighting.

What to Wear for a Rustic Wedding

The bride and groom are part of the decor too. Stiff, structured tuxedos clash with the relaxed mood. Try boho-inspired designs with floral embroidery. For the wedding party, brown leather boots instead of patent leather.



Your guests will appreciate cues. Say “semi-formal but comfortable shoes recommended”. Everyone will feel more at ease.
