Virtual Reality Station Categories

Not all virtual reality stations are identical. Know the difference:

Type Two: Standing Interactive

Attendee stands. Moves hands. Maybe moves body. Engages a basic interactive. Best for: Professional gatherings, company engagements. Duration: 5-7 minutes.

Category Three: Space-Scale

Attendee ambulates. Substantial area needed (3m x 3m <https://kollysphere.com/> minimum). Complete physique monitoring. Most suitable for: High-end events, gaming tournaments. Duration: 10-15 minutes. Expensive.

Category Four: Group Participation

Multiple guests simultaneously. See each other in VR. Rivalry or collaboration. Most suitable for: Group development, substantial celebrations. Duration: Fifteen to twenty minutes. Most expensive.

Concealed Expenses Requiring Inquiry

Stated cost is never the final price. Inquire regarding:

Transportation (to your venue). Installation (hours of staff time). Dismantling (also hours). Personnel (included or extra). Number of staff (one or two). Sanitization (between attendees). Alternative devices (in case of failure). Overtime (if event runs late).

Example: Quoted price RM5,000. Addition of transportation five hundred. Plus setup RM500. Addition of personnel one thousand. Total RM7,000. Forty percent increased.

Space Requirements: Bigger Than You Think

Customers minimize area requirements. The VR booth itself is one thing. The waiting line is another. The observation zone is another element.

Minimum area for a basic station: 2m x 2m for equipment. Plus two by two meters for line. Plus one by two meters for observation. Total five by two meters. That's ten square meters. For one station.

For space-scale: Three by three meters for activity zone. Plus line. Plus viewing. Total 5m x 4m. Twenty square meters.

Measure your venue. Provide measurements. Arrange coordinator inspection. Prior to reservation.

Live productions include site visits. Consistently. No deviations. Too many things can go wrong.

Power and Tech Requirements

VR booths consume significant electricity. Each processing unit draws 500-1000 watts. Each headset draws additional. Sum for a dual-station: 2000-3000 watts. Like running a hair dryer and a microwave simultaneously.

Ask: How many power outlets do you need? Where should they be located? Do you require exclusive electrical lines? What occurs if electricity fails?

Additionally inquire: Internet requirements. Some VR experiences need data retrieval. Some require online multiplayer. Some function without connection. Know before your venue's WiFi fails.

Good content: Related to your brand. Entertaining. Short. Easy to understand. Absence of simulation discomfort.
