Choosing Blooms for Bohemian Weddings

Bohemian themes remain incredibly popular. Think dried grasses, loose arrangements, and organic shapes. When selecting blooms for a boho celebration, prioritize airiness and flow.

Dried palms and lagurus bring the rustic, earthy vibe. Combine with blush tones, creams, and muted oranges. Steer clear of formal, structured bouquets because the theme celebrates imperfection.

Minimalist Floral Selections That Stun

Pick stems that make a statement alone. Green hydrangeas clustered in a concrete trough define contemporary style. Don't add filler flowers just because.

Choosing Blooms for Country Themes

Rustic weddings aren't going anywhere. Imagine wildflowers, herbs, and backyard abundance. When picking blooms for a rustic celebration, lean into what feels familiar and warm.

Sunflowers, chamomile daisies, and solidago all feel right for rustic themes. Mix in plenty of greenery—eucalyptus, ferns, olive branches. Steer clear of anything that feels too formal or exotic unless your barn wedding is in a very different climate.

Wrap bouquets in burlap or kraft paper. Container choice makes or breaks the look.

Floral Selections That Handle Humidity

Tropical celebrations feel magical. However, picking blooms for a hot, humid day requires special considerations. Salt spray damages delicate flowers.

Pick blooms that thrive in humidity. Anthurium, orchid varieties, and frangipani survive the sun and salt. Skip hydrangeas, peonies, and sweet peas. You'll be disappointed by 3pm.

Use whites, creams, soft blues, and seafoam green. Pink ginger blooms with palm fronds photograph beautifully.

Ask your florist about heat tolerance before you order.

Seasonal Flower Selection by Theme

One of the smartest approaches to choosing flowers for your wedding theme is working with nature's calendar. Seasonal flowers are cheaper.

If your theme is fresh and floral, Pick sweet peas, anemones, and hyacinths. For summer weddings with boho or rustic themes, Calla lilies, snapdragons, and delphinium fit too.

If your theme is warm, cozy, and rich, Go with dried flowers, preserved leaves, and wheat. If you're planning a formal, chic celebration, amaryllis, anemones, and paperwhites work beautifully.
