No-see-um mesh, likewise called 20x20 or 20x30 weave, obstructs tiny bugs that breeze in during the wetter months. It lowers air movement and lowers light a little, so I recommend it for bedrooms backing to greenbelt or water, except every opening in the house.

Solar display textile obstructs a high portion of solar heat gain.
