1. Dark streaks are spreading across shingle surfaces.
2. Moss or lichen is visible, especially near shaded sections.
3. Roof valleys have trapped leaves, sticks, or seed debris.
4. Gutters overflow even after rain that does not seem especially heavy.
5. The roof still functions, but the house looks noticeably neglected from the street.

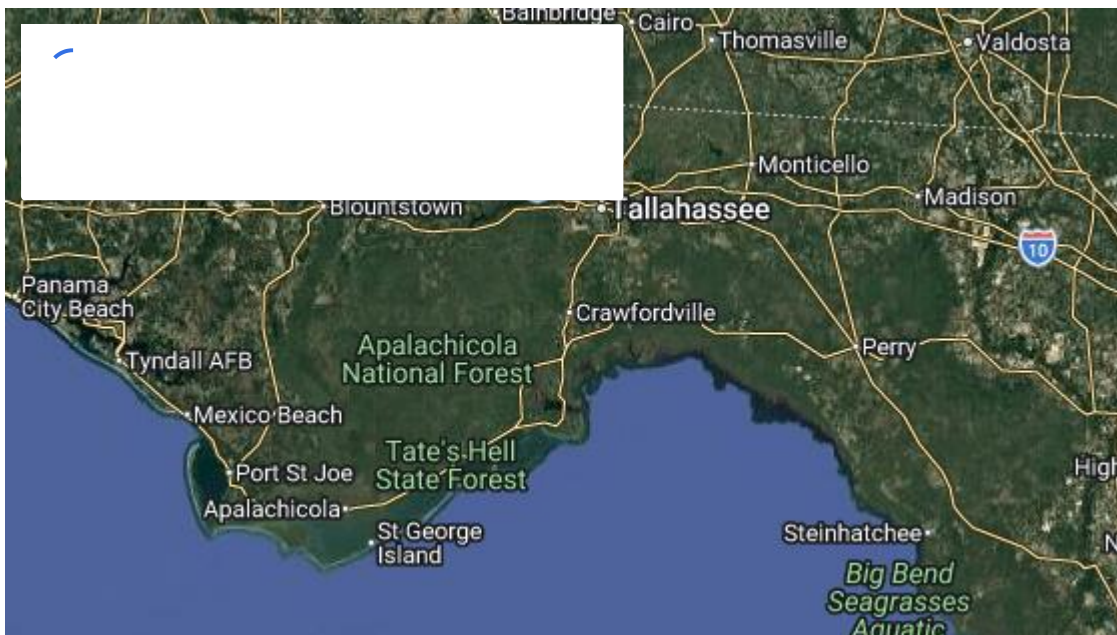
