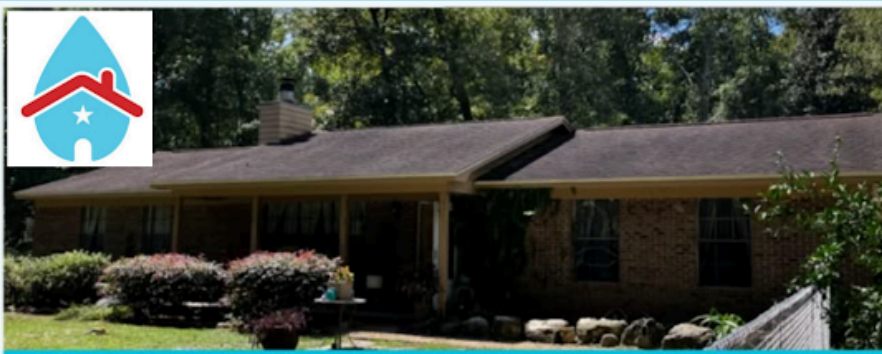
It can support energy performance, though expectations should stay realistic

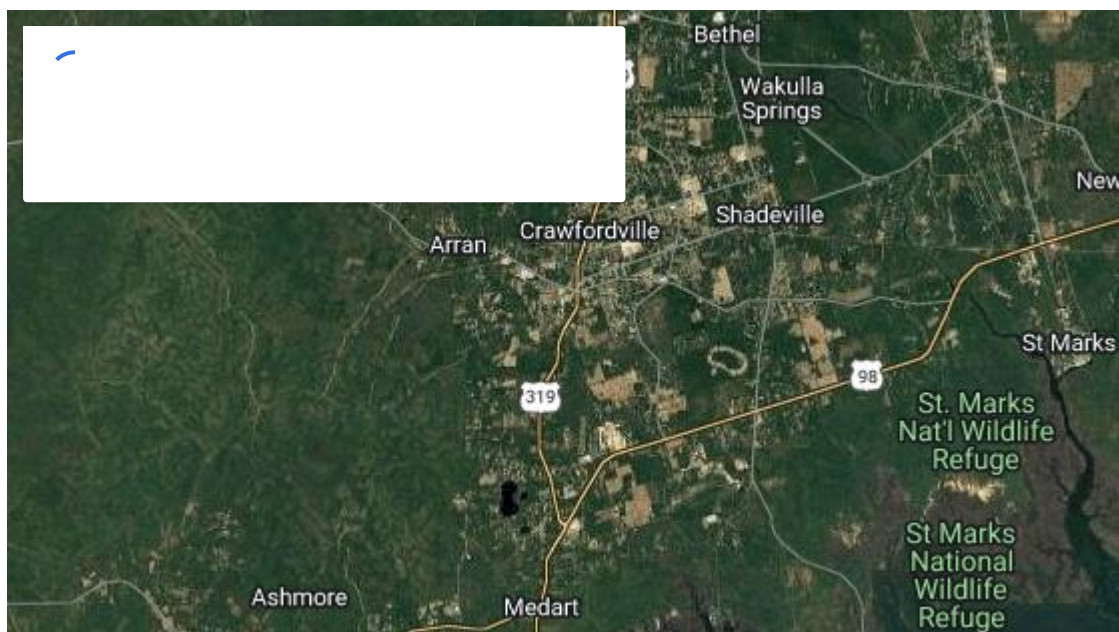
