



How to Change a Delta Flight: Fees & Policy Guide

Travel plans can change unexpectedly due to work, weather, family commitments, or other circumstances. Fortunately, Delta provides several options for modifying an eligible reservation before departure. Understanding the **Delta Flight Change** process can help travelers choose a different date, time, or destination while avoiding unnecessary costs. The amount you pay depends on your ticket type, travel origin, destination, and the price of the replacement flight. Delta recommends making changes before departure because tickets that are not changed or canceled in time may have no remaining value.

Delta's Current Fare Experiences

Delta organizes many fares into three main experiences: Basic, Classic, and Extra. Delta Main Basic is the lowest-cost option and generally has more restrictions. Delta Main Classic offers greater flexibility, while Extra and refundable options provide additional flexibility for eligible itineraries.

Your fare experience is important when considering a Delta Flight Change because the applicable fee can vary significantly. Before changing a reservation, travelers should check the ticket details in My Trips to understand the specific conditions attached to their booking.



When Delta Flight Changes Are Free?

For eligible Delta Classic and Extra tickets originating in the United States and Canada, Delta generally does not charge a change fee. This applies to travel to many destinations worldwide. However, a fare difference may still apply when the replacement flight costs more than the original ticket.

For example, if your original ticket costs \$300 and your new flight costs \$380, you may need to pay the \$80 difference even though there is no separate change fee. If the new flight costs less, you may receive an eCredit for the eligible difference.

Delta Basic Ticket Change Fees

Delta Main Basic tickets have more restrictions than Classic or Extra experiences. For many eligible tickets, changes or cancellations after the 24-hour risk-free period involve a fee, with the exact amount depending on the origin, destination, and ticket conditions.

Delta's current fee tables show that Basic change or cancellation fees can range from approximately \$99 to \$500 depending on itinerary and fare type. Certain international and regional markets have different rules. Because these fees can change based on where the trip begins, travelers should check Delta's current fee information before confirming a change.

24-Hour Risk-Free Cancellation

One useful option is Delta's 24-hour risk-free cancellation policy. Tickets purchased directly from Delta, including Delta Basic experiences, can generally be canceled within 24 hours of booking for a full refund, provided the applicable conditions are met. This can be helpful if you notice a mistake shortly after booking or realize that your travel dates need to be adjusted. Instead of completing a traditional Delta Flight Change, you may be able to cancel within the qualifying period and make a new reservation with the correct details.

How to Change a Delta Flight Online?

Changing a Delta reservation online is generally straightforward. Start by visiting Delta's website and opening My Trips. Select the reservation you want to modify and choose "Change or Add Flights."

Next, review the available replacement flights and select the option that works best for your schedule. Delta will display applicable change fees and any fare difference before you complete the transaction. Review the details carefully, confirm the change, and keep the updated itinerary or confirmation email for your records.

Fare Differences and Additional Costs

A change fee is only one potential cost. Travelers should also consider the fare difference between the original and new flights. If the replacement flight is more expensive, Delta generally requires payment of the difference.

If the replacement itinerary is less expensive, the eligible remaining value may be issued as an eCredit, depending on the ticket conditions. Therefore, comparing several available flights before selecting a new itinerary can help reduce the total cost of a Delta Flight Change.

Same-Day Flight Changes

Delta also offers same-day options for eligible domestic itineraries. Same-Day Confirmed may allow an eligible passenger to move to another flight on the same day, subject to availability and applicable conditions.

For eligible Classic tickets, Same-Day Confirmed can cost \$75, while the service may be complimentary for qualifying Extra or refundable experiences and certain Medallion members. Delta Basic experiences are not eligible for Same-Day Confirmed or Same-Day Standby. Travelers should check availability and eligibility before relying on a same-day change.

Changing International Flights

International Delta Flight Change rules can vary considerably based on the country where travel begins and the ticket type. While eligible Classic and Extra fares originating in the United States and Canada may have no change fee, some international-origin itineraries can have applicable fees.
