 A delayed flight can disrupt your plans, but you may have a right to compensation depending on your route, delay length, and the reason for the disruption. If you are wondering about [Iberia flight delay compensation](#), the first step is to understand which passenger-protection rules apply to your journey.

How Much Iberia Flight Delay Compensation Can You Claim?

For eligible flights covered by EU passenger-rights rules, compensation can potentially be up to €600 per passenger. The amount generally depends on the flight distance and your arrival delay at the final destination.

As a general guide:

- €250 – eligible flights up to 1,500 km

- €400 – certain flights between 1,500 and 3,500 km
- €600 – certain longer flights

However, compensation is not automatic. Extraordinary circumstances, such as severe weather, air-traffic-control restrictions, or certain security-related events, can affect eligibility.

When Are You Eligible for Iberia Delay Compensation?

You may have a stronger compensation claim when:

- Your flight arrives significantly late at the final destination.
- The disruption was within the airline's responsibility.
- The applicable passenger-rights regulations cover your journey.
- You were not informed of the cancellation or delay within the required timeframe.

Keep your boarding pass, booking confirmation, delay notifications, receipts, and flight details. These documents can make your claim easier to support.

How to Submit an Iberia Compensation Claim

Passengers searching for an [Iberia flight delay compensation form](#) or Iberia compensation claim form should use Iberia's official customer-service or claims channels and provide accurate booking information.

An Iberia compensation form online may ask for details such as your flight number, travel date, passenger information, and the nature of your disruption. What About Cancelled Flights?

A cancellation can involve different rights from a delay. Your refund or cancellation rights can depend on your fare, booking conditions, route, and applicable law.

What Should You Do After an Iberia Flight Delay?

1. Check your actual arrival time.
2. Identify the reason for the delay.
3. Save all travel documents and receipts.
4. Check whether passenger-rights rules apply.
5. Submit your claim with complete and accurate information.
6. Keep the claim reference for future follow-up.
