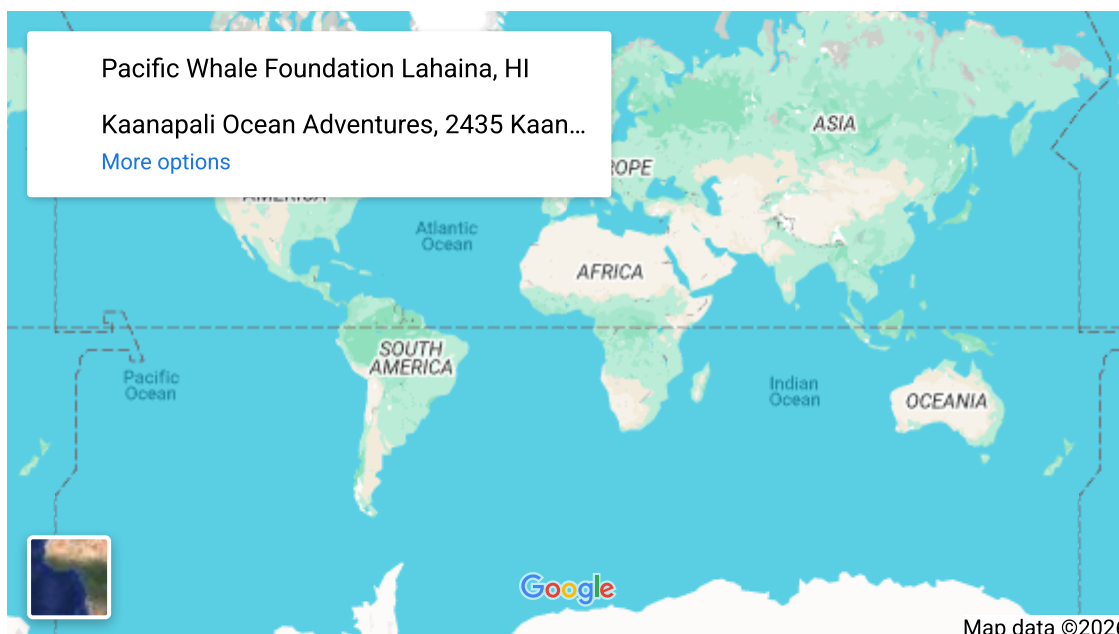


Kaanapali Ocean Adventures is committed to providing ocean experiences to guests with a range of physical abilities. Understanding the specific physical requirements of the tours helps guests with mobility considerations make informed booking decisions. The boarding process uses a 14-foot [Kaanapali snorkeling](#) hard-bottom inflatable raft to transfer guests from Kaanapali Beach to the Sanity moored offshore. Guests must be able to climb in and out of this raft, which involves stepping over the inflatable tube wall while the raft is in shallow water or low surf. On calm days this is straightforward. On days with higher surf, the movement of the raft creates a more challenging boarding environment. Guests with mobility limitations, prosthetics, or physical conditions that affect their ability to climb in and out of a raft should contact Kaanapali Ocean Adventures before booking to discuss their specific situation. The team can advise on whether the boarding conditions on a given tour date are appropriate.

Snorkeling itself is accessible to guests who are comfortable in the water even with limited mobility. The flotation equipment provided, including life jackets, noodles, and boogie boards, allows guests to snorkel without swimming ability if they are comfortable floating on the surface. The onboard Sanity vessel has facilities appropriate for guests who need a rest during the water portion of the tour. The sun-covered deck, seating, and bathroom are accessible without requiring swimming capability. Sea Scooters can be particularly helpful for guests who find sustained swimming challenging, as the propulsion device eliminates the energy demand of covering reef distances. For guests who find the Kaanapali Ocean Adventures boarding process too physically demanding, Captain Dan and the crew can advise on the most appropriate alternative for their specific situation.
