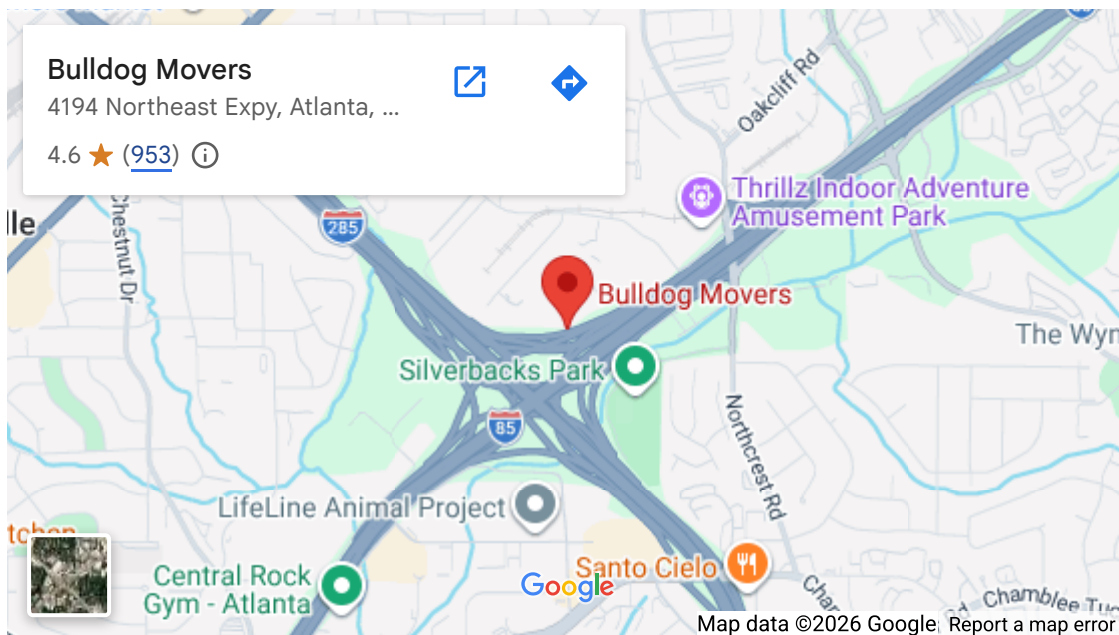

Basic carrier liability, sometimes called released value protection, covers a set amount per pound of an item. Full value protection offers stronger coverage and is worth discussing if you are moving valuable furniture or electronics.
