No-see-um mesh, also called 20x20 or 20x30 weave, blocks little insects that wind in during the wetter months. It decreases air movement and lowers light somewhat, so I recommend it for rooms backing to greenbelt or water, except every opening in the house.

Solar screen textile obstructs a high portion of solar heat gain. It alters the outside appearance of the home and the indoor light high quality, however it can reduce afternoon space temperature levels by numerous degrees. Frame and spline: small parts that matter
