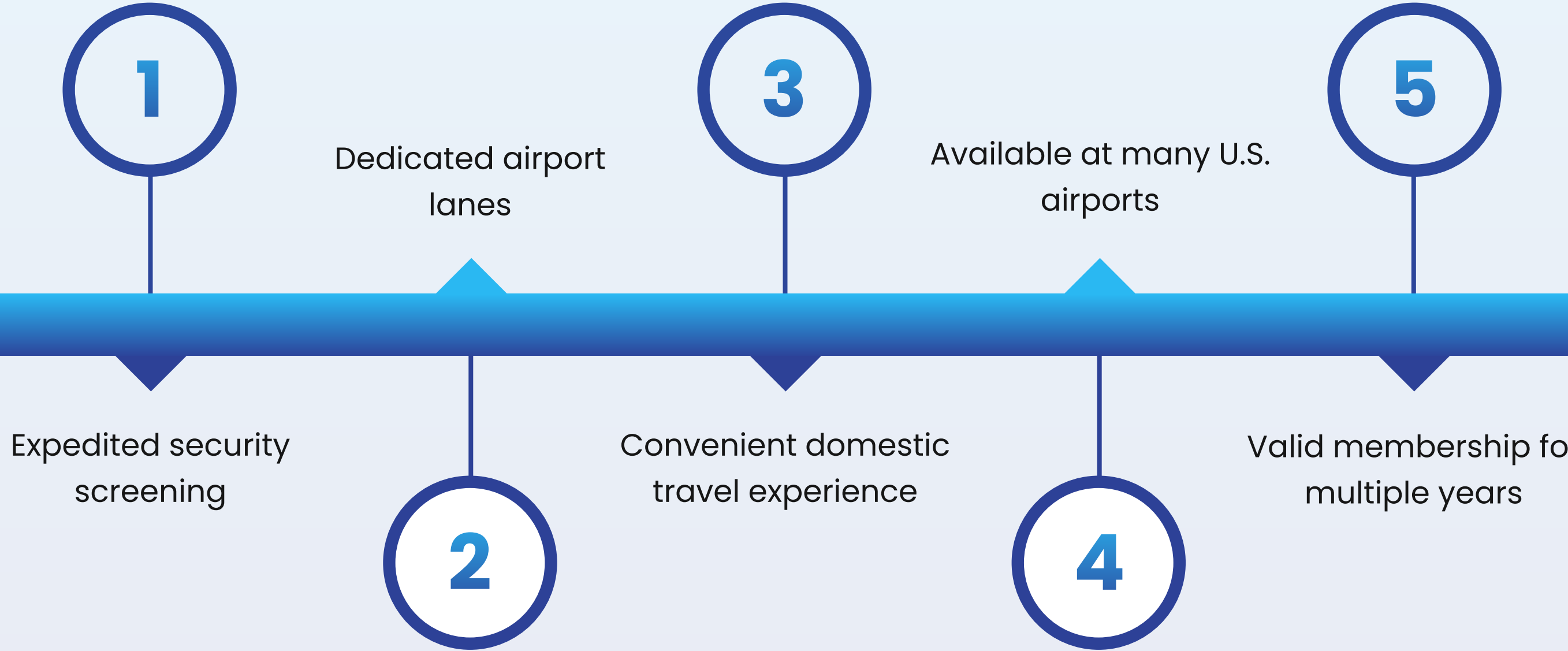

Fees and Membership Details

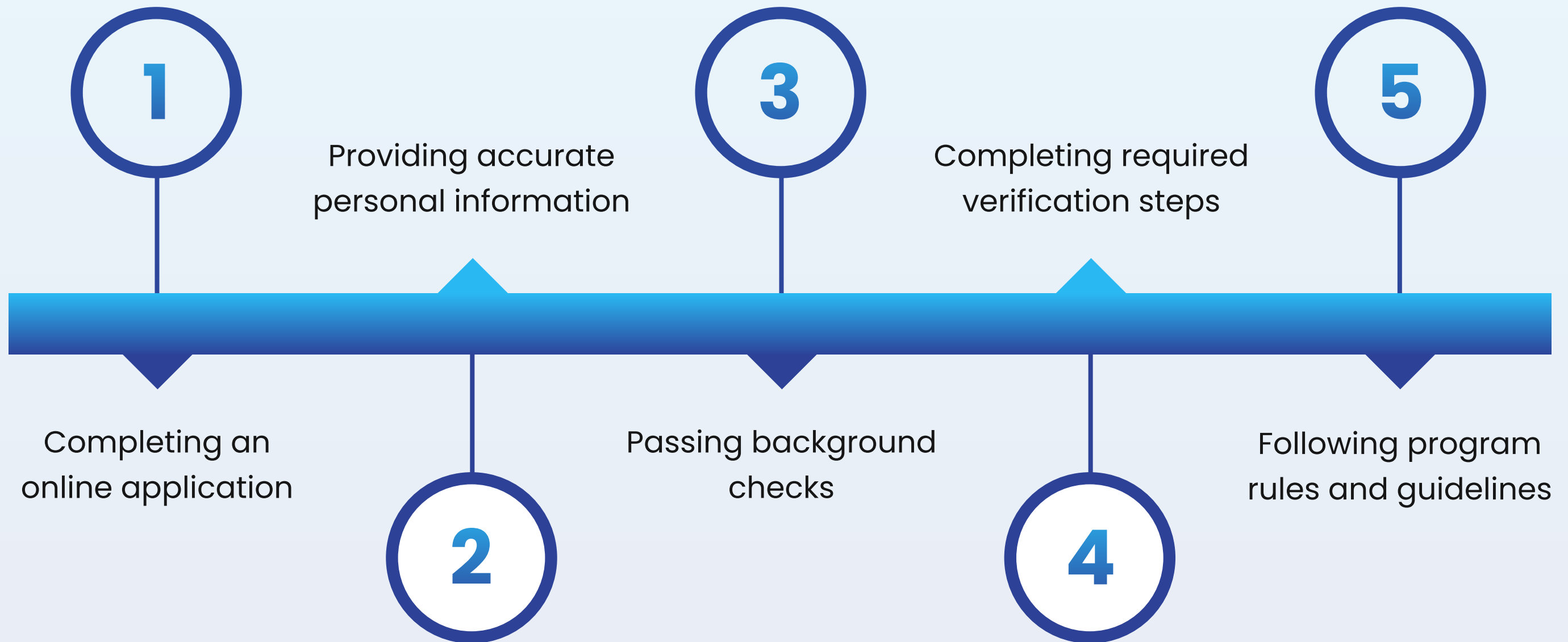
