What makes emergency locksmith Orlando service different?

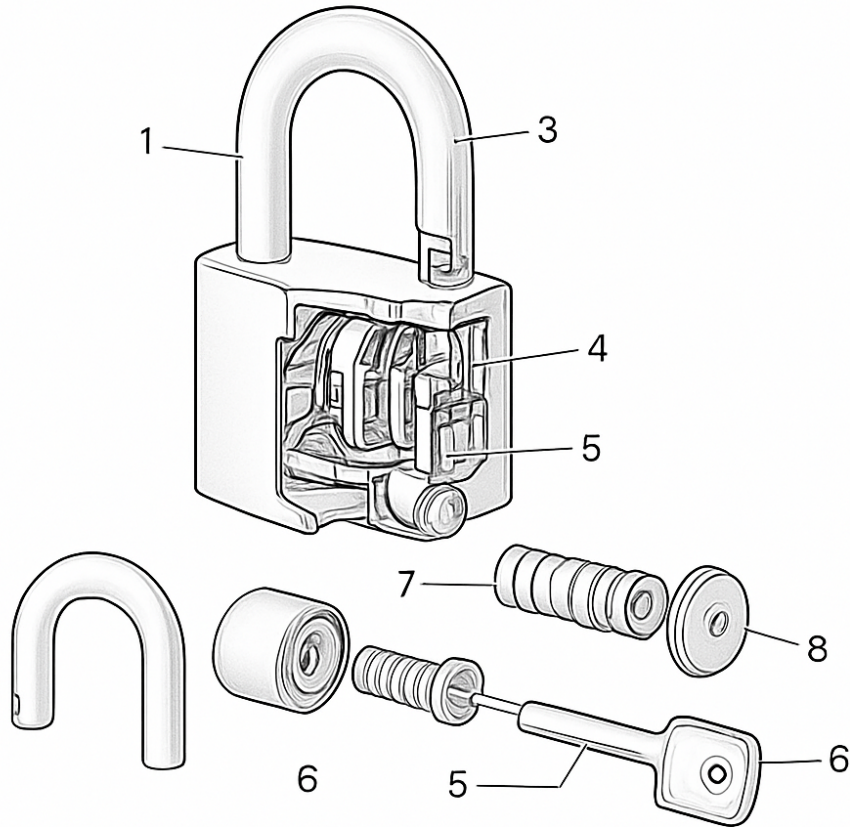
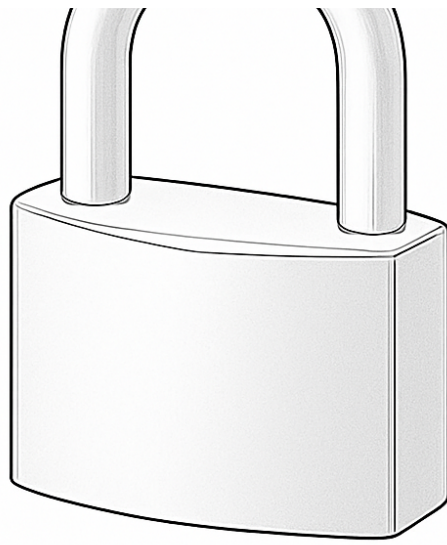

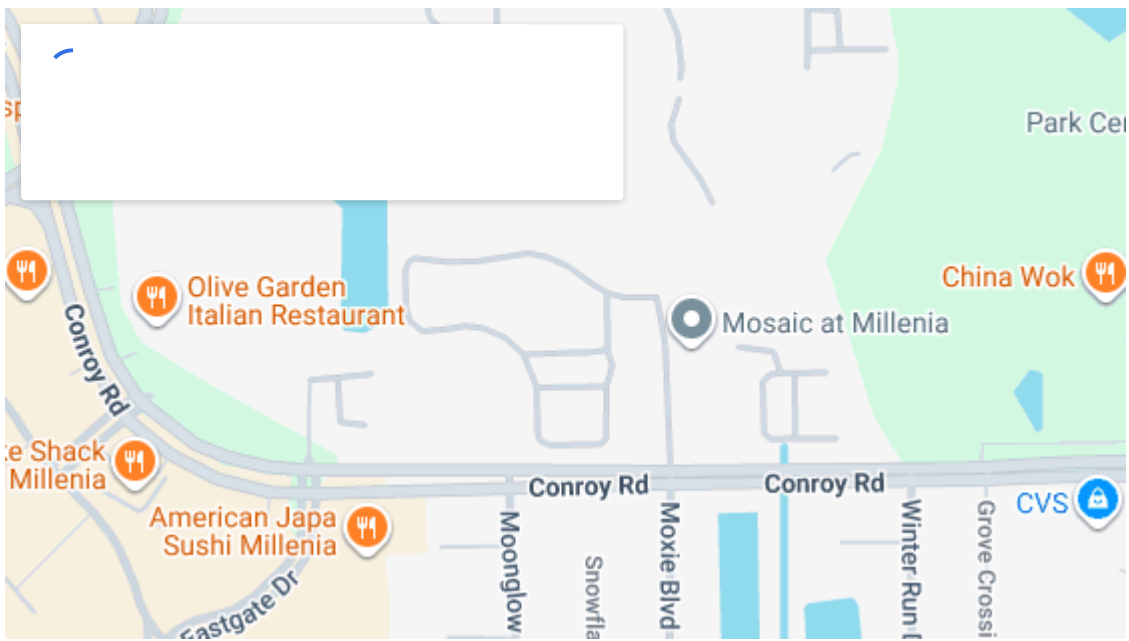
