

A garage door is the largest moving object in many homes. When it works, you touch the remote and forget about it. - Refresh remotes and keypads. Change batteries in handheld remotes and the exterior keypad. Reprogram if the opener light blinks several times without moving. If the wall button runs the door but remotes do not,

- Clean and straighten the photo-eyes. Clean both sensing unit lenses with a soft fabric. The lights on each sensor should be consistent, not flickering. Adjust the brackets so the lenses face each other directly and rest 4 to 6 inches off the floor, after that test by passing a box with the beam of light as the door closes.
- Clear and oil the course. Move debris from the tracks, then clean the rollers and joints with a rag. Use a garage door rated lube, not oil, to rollers, hinges, and torsion springtime birthing plates. Do not lube the tracks themselves. If you have a chain drive opener, a bit of oil on subjected chain sections can reduce chatter.
- Test equilibrium and guidebook release carefully. With the door shut, draw the red release cord to separate the opener. Lift the door by hand to mid height.
